Message from the Head teacher:

What a windy week! Well done to everyone who has managed to get to school on time every day through the wind and the rain. Attendance is too low at the moment. Healthy Club:

The school is running a free 'Let's Get Healthy' Club on Monday's from the 24 September at 3:15-4:30. The club runs for six weeks for children aged 4-6, and ten weeks for children aged 7-12. They are interactive and fun sessions, with parents attending the entire session for the younger group, and only the last 20 minutes of the sessions for the older group.

Workshops include learning about sugary drinks and food swapping for healthier snacks, making smoothies, and blindfold fruit & veg taste testing, and also activities and games such as parachute games and shuttle races.
