

Message from the Headteacher:

Dear parents/carers

Year 4 had a fantastic start to their learning about the Egyptians with a visit from History off the Page who taught the children lots of interesting facts and craft activities to give them a good understanding of Egyptian life.

Year 4 have also been participating in the new Multiplication Timetable Check which asks them 25 times table questions. They have been practicing lots in preparation for this.

This week our year 1 children have all taken part in the phonics screening check. This check is designed to assess how well the children can decode and read words. The children work with their familiar school adults on this activity and have tried really hard.

Reception had some very exciting visitors on Tuesday this week; some emergency services workers stopped by with their vehicles to teach the children about their jobs - some lucky children even got to sit in the vehicles! This links to their learning about real life superheroes.

Sports Day is scheduled to take place this year on Friday 28th June. Key Stage 2 will have their Sports Day in the morning from 9:30 - 11:30 while Reception and Key Stage 1 will have theirs in the afternoon from 1:00 - 3:00 p.m.

All the children are going to be put into houses. There are 7 houses, namely Respect, Equality, Self-worth, Partnership, Enjoyment, Communication and Trust. We have chosen these names for the houses as they are Lime Academy's values. We will begin the day with a carousel of activities for all the children to participate in. This will be followed by races at the end. All activities will be awarded points, which will be tallied up at the end of the day and the winning house will be announced the following week during Assembly.
